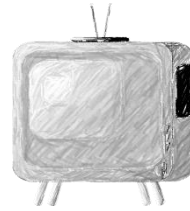
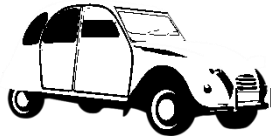
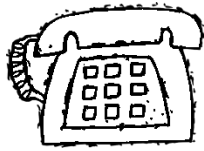


Dear Parents,



In History in term 2 we are looking at the topic 'How family life has changed or remained the same over time.' and how we can show that the present is different from or similar to the past. During the next month I have a survey I would like the children to talk about with their grandparents or older relatives and friends - the personal connection makes the learning relevant and the follow up we do becomes more engaging and purposeful with this personal link. I hope the framework makes it easy to gather information and the best recording ways could be dot points, diagrams, notes - anything that is easily read and recorded. Recording can be done by the children (it doesn't have to have correct spelling as it's a data collection exercise) or an adult as they talk about it with the children. Together we will collate and compare the **then** and **now** information based on their survey work.

I am hoping your child finds this a fun task to do and the learning will definitely be interesting when they realize the extent of the changes. I am aiming to have these surveys returned by Friday of week 1 (term 2), but they can be returned anytime before then.
