

Information about Week 8 Sharing – my daily route to school

As a part of our learning in Geography the children are expected to represent the location of places and features of those places.

*As a lead up to our class work on this, in week 8 Sharing time the children have been asked to **share their daily route to school** with the class and to include information related to how and where they change direction and what features they see along the way. So when you come to school with your child, talk about how you get there (using terms like left, right around the roundabout, across the road), as well as landmarks they might see along the way (childcare, kindy, bus stop, a friend's house or a stop sign). Sharing could be presented as a map drawn by your child with some labels, a verbal description, a map with a few photos or presented as a recounted story – just using some of the terms outlined above.*
